- Following the inauguration of CCAICACB in Grenada 2015, the IC and the FIU have worked jointly including the presentation of Country Papers
- The IC has benefitted significantly from Commonwealth Secretariat's inputs:
 - A robust anti-corruption system Systems Hub and National Anti-Corruption Round Table Mechanism
 - Identified as a "best practice"

Complaints Form and Procedure

- Updated Complaints Procedure and Generic Complaints Form adopted in keeping with Part IV IPLA, Code-of-Conduct
- Three (3) written Complaints received
 - Alleged wrongdoing by senior official
 - Alleged Conflict of Interest by Government Ministers
 - Alleged non-compliance with procedures and legislations within a public entity



Complaints via Public Newspapers

- Data Gathering and Verification phase
 - Improper use of cell phones by public officials
 - * Al Jazeera Reports re sale of Diplomatic Passports
- Completion of Preliminary Report phase
 - Alleged gratification by Senior Public Officer re Government Project.



Investigation Marketing National Importing Board (MNIB) Operations

- Complainant filed IC had no jurisdiction to investigate MNIB. Justice Smith ruled in favour of IC June 2019.
- Inquiry Phase of investigation commenced October 2019.



MNIB operations

- Stay of execution and appeal against June ruling filed. Justice Baptiste did not grant Stay, but paused on investigations pending outcome of the appeal of Justice Smith's ruling.
- ❖IC filing appeal to Court of Appeal-outcome would form Precedent for the region.
